## **Strategic Plan Performance Review – 2025-26**

The Strategic Plan Performance Review for the year 2025-26 has been prepared to assess the institution's continued progress and advancements towards the goals outlined in the Strategic Plan 2023–2028. The review demonstrates significant improvements across various strategic domains including academic quality, research productivity, industry collaborations, infrastructure enhancement, student development, faculty training, quality assurance practices, alumni networking and community engagement initiatives. The defined metrics and performance indicators have supported effective monitoring of institutional performance and outcome-based growth. The review highlights the institution's commitment towards sustained development, quality enhancement and achievement of long-term institutional objectives through structured planning and continuous evaluation.

### **1. Improving Academic Quality**

During 2025, nearly 30% of eligible programs progressed towards accreditation documentation works completion. The university examination pass percentage improved further to 72% through strengthened academic support systems. Faculty publication output increased to nearly 10% compared to the previous academic year.

### **2. Enhancing Research and Innovation**

External research funding increased to approximately ₹4.8 lakhs. Faculty members and students initiated the process of patent filing, while citation count and institutional h-index showed notable improvement.

### **3. Strengthening Industry Partnerships**

Industry collaborations increased to 15 active partnerships during 2025-26. Industry-supported projects were initiated to strengthen applied learning and research. Placement



percentage improved to nearly 85% through enhanced industry networking and employability training.

#### **4. Improving Infrastructure and Facilities**

Laboratories were modernized with advanced equipment and software support. Library resources and digital databases increased by nearly 18%, while internet bandwidth was also improved.

#### **5. Enhancing Student Life and Experience**

The number of active student clubs increased to 7 during 2025-26. Student participation in extracurricular activities rose to nearly 52%. Eight major campus events including symposiums, culturals, sports meets and entrepreneurship activities were successfully organized.

#### **6. Faculty Development and Training**

Faculty participation in conferences increased to nearly 40%, while around more than 50% of faculty members attended FDPs and professional development programmes. The percentage of faculty members with Ph.D qualifications increased in the academic year, 2025-26.

#### **7. Quality Assurance and Accreditation**

The IQAC strengthened quality monitoring systems through periodic academic and administrative audits. Nearly 85% of departments completed internal quality assessment and accreditation compliance activities.

#### **8. Student Feedback and Grievance Redressal**

Student participation in feedback collection increased to nearly 72% during 2025-26. The grievance redressal mechanism achieved 95% resolution efficiency, with most grievances resolved within four working days.



## 9. Alumni Engagement and Networking

Three alumni networking events were conducted during the year. Alumni participation increased in placement support, guest lectures, workshops and student mentoring initiatives.

## 10. Community Engagement and Outreach

The institution conducted 5 outreach and extension activities during 2025-26, benefitting nearly 950 community members. Collaborations with five local organizations and industries strengthened institutional outreach and social responsibility initiatives.

### Overall Institutional Progress Summary – 2025-26

During the year 2025-26, the institution achieved considerable progress across multiple strategic areas through consistent implementation of planned initiatives and quality improvement practices. Significant advancements were witnessed in accreditation preparedness, research and innovation, industry collaborations, infrastructure modernization, student engagement, faculty empowerment and institutional governance. The institution also strengthened its outcome-based practices and quality assurance mechanisms to support sustainable institutional growth.
